Findings of Fact

After review of the file and related materials submitted with regard to the above noted application, pursuant to Title 38, Maine Revised Statutes (M.R.S.) § 590 and 06-096 Code of Maine Rules (C.M.R.) ch. 115, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (the Department) finds the following facts:

I. Registration

McCain Foods USA, Inc. has requested the transfer of Air Emission License A-465-71-J-R/A and subsequently issued amendment A-465-71-K-A from Penobscot McCrum, LLC to McCain Foods USA, Inc. through a letter to the Department dated March 9, 2026. Air Emission License A-465-71-J-R/A was issued to Penobscot McCrum, LLC on December 2, 2022. The facility is a potato processing facility.

All rules, regulations, or statutes referenced in this air emission license refer to the amended version in effect as of the issued date of this license.

II. Transfer Requirements

A. Title, Right, or Interest

In their application, McCain Foods USA, Inc. submitted copies of ownership transfer documents transferring ownership of the facility to McCain Foods USA, Inc. The parties have provided sufficient evidence of title, right, or interest in the facility to allow the transfer of the facility's licenses.

B. Technical Capacity and Intent

McCain Foods USA, Inc.'s acquisition of the facility is not expected to result in any significant change in the employees who currently operate the equipment and facilities and conduct activities relative to the air emission license. The facility's regulatory history with the Department demonstrates that the environmental personnel are competent in air pollution control. The information submitted in the application provides sufficient evidence that McCain Foods USA, Inc. has the technical capacity and intent to comply with their air emission license.

McCain Foods USA, Inc. certifies that there will be no increase in air emissions beyond that provided for in the existing licenses, either in quantity or type.


Order
